PARTIALS (REMOVABLE BRIDGEWORK)

Can rock or stress teeth - may loosen own natural teeth

Usually some amount of movement from the partial CONSEQUENCES OF NOT HAVING WORK DONE OPPOSTPONING

BONDED FACINGS **EXTRACTIONS**

BENEFITS:

Last resort for non-salvageable tooth

Eliminate pain

Remove teeth that are out of position

Eliminate infection

POSSIBLE COMPLICATIONS:

Fractured particles may remain

Irritation to nerves may cause temporary or permanent numbness

Part or all of tooth may be lodged in sinus, requiring more surgery

Bad infections may take long time to clear up

Jaw may be stiff and difficult to open for a time

If Jawbone is very weak it may fracture

Spread of infection

Swelling

Pain
